Launch of MuVie: a project to revolutionise music education for the visually impaired

The MuVie consortium is happy to announce the launch of a ground-breaking initiative to improve music education for visually impaired people. Funded by the European Union's Erasmus+ programme, MuVie brings together experts from across Europe to develop innovative tools that make music learning more accessible.

The project focuses on three main objectives:

- **To create an online Braille music library:** a repository of 5,000 pages of accessible sheet music.
- **Development of AI-driven tools:** enabling easy navigation and enhanced interaction with digital music formats.
- **Training educators:** Providing resources and training to integrate digital solutions into the music classroom.
